Fergie Jenkins Fergie Jenkins grew up in Canada, where he excelled in baseball, basketball, and hockey, competing in Canada's highest amateur hockey league. Upon graduation from high school in the early 1960s, he signed with the Philadelphia Phillies. Jenkins also played for the Chicago Cubs, Texas Rangers, and Boston Red Sox, from 1965 through 1983. In 1991, Jenkins became the first Canadian to be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame. He was the first Canadian and Cubs pitcher to win a Cy Young Award. Jenkins was inducted into the

Canadian Baseball Hall of Fame in 1987, and in 1991, became the first Canadian ever elected to the Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, New York.

Dick Schaap Memorial Award for Excellence in Media Recipient



Dick Enberg Richard Alan “Dick” Enberg, Ph.D. provided play-by-play for various sports on numerous radio and television networks over the course of his 60+ year career. Enberg joined NBC Sports in 1975, broadcasting for many events, including the National Football League, Major League Baseball, the National Basketball Association, the U.S. Open golf championship, college football, college basketball, the Wimbledon and French Open tennis tournaments, heavyweight boxing, and the Olympic Games. Enberg was hired by CBS Sports in 2000, serving as a play-by-play announcer. Enberg has garnered many awards and honors over the years, including 13 Sports Emmy Awards, nine National Sportscaster of the Year awards and induction into that organization's Hall of Fame, five Sportscaster of the Year awards, the Pete Rozelle Award, the Curt Gowdy Award, and the Ford Frick Award. Enberg was inducted into the Rose Bowl Hall of Fame on December 31, 2011.

Rabbi Elimelech Goldberg Rabbi Elimelech Goldberg, who holds a First-Degree Black Belt in the Korean art of Choi Kwon Do, first provided a therapeutic martial arts program at Camp Simcha, where he served as the Director from 1990 to 2002. Having lost his first child to leukemia at the age of 2 years, Rabbi Goldberg brings a wealth of experience and sensitivity to help families facing life-threatening illness. His commitment to ease the pain of very sick children resulted in the creation of the Kids Kicking Cancer organization in June, 1999. Rabbi Goldberg was a recipient of the Robert Wood Johnson Community Health Leader's Award (2004) and the McCarty Cancer Foundation's Humanitarian of the Year Award (2004). Kids Kicking Cancer has provided free lessons and support for 5,000 children and their families. In March 2012, Goldberg was featured in People Magazine in their “Heroes Among Us” feature. In 2014 Rabbi Goldberg was nominated for the CNN heroes program.
